<u>MISSIONARY OF THE MONTH CAUSE - (MARCH) - ELAM</u>

Elam Ministries Executive Director is David Yeghnazar. He is a young man, whose father Sam Yeghnazar, together with senior Iranian church leaders, founded Elam Ministries in 1990. David's grandfather, Seth Yeghnazar came to Christ in Iran in the 1930's. In the 1950's he held a prayer meeting in his Tehran home every night. Today, many estimate that a million or more Iranians from a Muslim background have come to Christ. There are now house churches all over Iran; Bibles are getting into the country; and more Iranians than ever are being trained for leadership. Thanks to advances in technology, ministry to Iran is rapidly expanding.

Iran is much in the news these days and will continue to be so due to the current political situation both there and in the surrounding countries. The Iranian nation was previously known as Persia and has been a nation for over 2,500 years since the days of Queen Esther in the Bible. The revolutionary Islamic regime came to power in 1979, bringing an end to their monarchy.

It is a nation in excess of 86 million people with much persecution of Christians whose government opposes Christianity, bans Bibles, arrests evangelists and threatens the lives of converts to Christianity from Islam. It is the second largest country in the Middle East, with vast reserves of oil and gas.

The Iranian people whilst being disillusioned have become the most open to Christ in the region. The church is growing faster than at any other time since the arrival of Islam in the 7th century.

Elam's ministry includes training church planters, women's, men's, youth and children's workers to serve many people inside Iran as well as refugees in the region, strengthening

house churches and fellowship with many thousands of one-to-one believers being discipled. They had a target last year to print in excess of 250,000 Persian New Testaments. Today the need for prayer is as great as ever. As the church grows, persecution is intensifying.
